Dear Parents,

As part of our ‘People Who Help Us’ topic the children will be visiting the local fire station on the above dates. The firefighters will give a talk about safety, their role within the community, and show the children around the station.

We are asking parents for a voluntary contribution of **£2.50** towards the cost of the coaches. The coaches are £80 per trip, between 87 children across the year, making the actual cost per child £2.76 – school will pay the difference. **Free School Meal Children**, i.e. those parents who are in receipt of certain benefits, (job seekers, income support, etc.), can use ‘Get into It’ funding to pay for the visit if they wish.

We also need volunteers to help supervise groups of children on the day. Any offers would be gratefully received. However, if we have too many offers we will pull names out of a hat.
