



## **Glendale Harvest Water Aid Appeal - Autumn 2015**

As part of our harvest theme this year, we have been looking at how individuals, working together, can make a difference.

Given the desperate plight of some African people who have no clean water to drink, we hope you will work with the school to support water aid. The children in each class have chosen the activities they would like to do in order to raise funds for water aid, and we are asking for your help in supporting them:

**All Reception Classes** – children are filling a class water bottle with change, which they have earned by carrying out jobs.

**Class 1WB** – have chosen to have a fun obstacle course in the school grounds. The course will have obstacles to climb over, crawl through, travel along etc. Parents are being asked to make a voluntary donation to fill a class jar to raise money.

**Class 1K** – are having ‘afternoon tea’. The children will make biscuits and cakes and will serve them to parents with squash – **not** tea or coffee.

**Class 1V** – are going to try and fill a watering can with pennies. Please support us by paying your child in pennies for small jobs done around the house.

**All Y2 Classes** – children will be jogging round the running track for 25 laps. We would like to invite parents to sponsor the children for a minimum of 2p per lap.
