NationalGrid – Heath End Road Closure, some of you will be aware that NationalGrid will be carrying out major gas works commencing 10th October for an estimated period of 8 weeks. Heath End Road will be closed between the Arbury Road junction and Atholl Crescent, with temporary traffic lights in place. Access will be for residents only. Traffic will be diverted via Greenmoor Road. We are concerned that this will cause congestion/gridlock/problems on other roads, particularly Croft Road and The Raywoods, where many parents and children cross. The work may continue in January.

Please take extra care, and allow extra time, when bringing/taking children to and from school, whether walking or driving.
