Dear Parents – KS1 Children,

In line with our topics this term the following visits/on site events have been arranged for our Y2 and Y1 children:

Town Planners – as part of our geography and technology topic this term on buildings, we have arranged for a team of Lego technology specialists to deliver a work shop in school constructing models of buildings to create a town. Children will use skills such as logic, maths, manual dexterity, practical design and teamwork during the work shop.

Museum – a morning's visit, by coach, has been arranged on the above dates. We would be grateful for some volunteers to help supervise the children during these visits. If you are able to help please see your child's teacher.

Mosque Visit - we have arranged a guided tour of Leicester Central Mosque on the above dates. The coach will leave at 9.15 a.m. We would be grateful for some volunteers to help supervise the children - if you are able to help us please see your child's teacher. The children will need a packed lunch. Children entitled to free school meals will automatically receive a packed lunch from school. You can, if you wish, order a packed lunch from school which needs to be ordered by **Friday 6th October**.

We are asking parents for a voluntary contribution of £14.00 per child towards the cost of the three events. If you have any problems or queries about the cost please see your child's teacher. As with any visit, either in or out of school, we do rely on contributions from parents - insufficient contributions may result in visits having to be cancelled.

Free School Meal Children, children from families in receipt of benefits, (job seekers, income support, etc.), can use 'Get into It' funding to pay for the visits if they wish.
