



Dear Parents – YR Children Topic Visits

In line with our topics this term we have arranged a visit to:

Ash End House Children’s Farm – 19th April 2018

As part of our topic work this term we have arranged a visit to Ash End House Children’s Farm on the above date. The visit may include activities such as: holding chick/ducklings, egg hunting – the children will bring home a fresh egg; hand feeding some animals. The visit also includes a birds of prey demonstration.

The children will need to wear sensible shoes and their school uniform. However, if the weather looks to be, or has been wet, they can wear jeans or joggers and wellies with their school jumpers.

The children will require a packed lunch, sent in a plastic bag, with throwaway wrappings/cartons, in order that all rubbish can be thrown away before returning to school. Children entitled to free school meals will automatically receive a packed lunch from school. You can, if you wish, order a packed lunch from school which needs to be ordered by Thursday 29th March (the day we break up for the Easter holiday). Coach/es will leave around 9.20am. and the children should be back in school by 3.00p.m.

We are asking parents for a voluntary contribution of **£14.00** towards the trip, which can be paid in three instalments of 2 x £5.00 and 1 x £4.00 per week. **As with any trip, we rely on contributions from parents - insufficient contributions may result in the trip having to be cancelled.** Costings for the trip are as follows:

Coaches, £520; entrance fees, £625.50 (£6.95 per child); adult supervision £64.35, (13 x £4.95 each adult. Due to the number of children we are able to have 11 free adults); Birds of Prey demonstration £45. Total costings £1254.85.

Free School Meals, children whose parents receive certain benefits – can use ‘Get Into It’ funding to pay for this trip. If any parent has any problems or queries about the cost, please see your child’s teacher. The children will not need any spending money on the day.

Volunteers are needed to help supervise groups of children on the day. Any offers of help would be gratefully received, although if we have too many, names will be drawn from a hat.
