**Enrichment of the curriculum**

We try to make coming to school as interesting and exciting as possible, as happy and engaged children learn well. To this end, we often have visits in from organisations, some of which we fund from school finances, and some visits out. Coach costs, entrance fees, the cost of instructors or guides are rising, but the work and enthusiasm generated amongst the children by these visits make them very worthwhile. However, the burden of payment for these trips rests on the parents. We propose that the total cost of trips out and visits in will come to no more than **£35** per child over the year for 2018/19.
